

Prof. Dr Sabine Roeser

Prof. Roeser was born in Haan in 1970. In 1990 she started her studies of arts at the Academy of Fine Arts in Maastricht from which she graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Arts degree. After that she studied philosophy at the University of Amsterdam. In 1997 she then obtained the Master of Arts cum laude; she also finished her studies of political sciences with a Master of Arts degree in 1998. Four years later, after working as a research assistant, she obtained her PhD in philosophy having written a doctoral thesis about “Ethical Institutions and Emotions” under the guidance of René van Woudenberg at the Institute of Philosophy of the Free University of Amsterdam. Till 2010 she worked as assistant professor at the Institute of Philosophy, Faculty for Technologies, Politics and Management at the Technical University of Delft. After this, she started working as associate professor at said Institute and in September 2010 she became full professor for political philosophy and ethics at the University of Twente. In her publications Prof. Roeser deals with a wide range of aspects concerning ethics and moral in technology.
