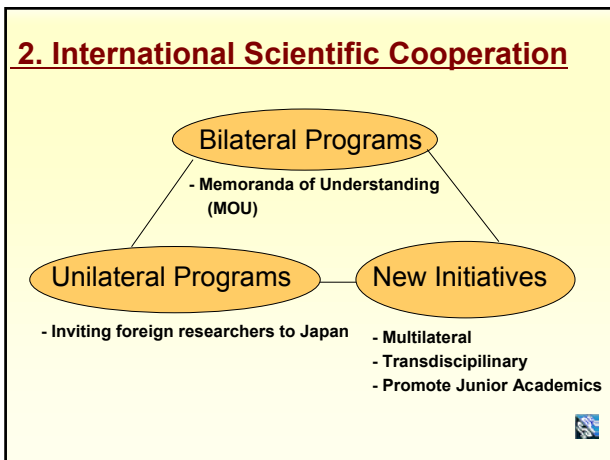
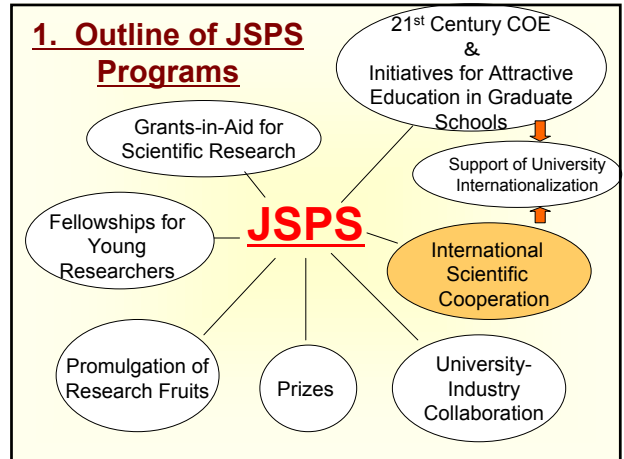

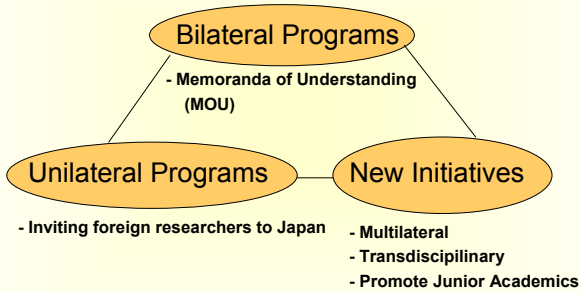

- Area of Cooperation: **All academic fields**
- Type of Activity:
Scientist exchanges
- *Duration: **2 weeks to 3 months**
- *Terms of Award for German researchers:
 - Daily allowance: **18,000 yen**
 - Domestic travel allowance: **100,000 yen**

- Area of Cooperation: **All academic fields**
- Type of Activity:
 - (1) **Eminent Scientist exchanges under its own award program: JSPS programs for German researchers**
 - *Duration: **within 12 months**
 - *Terms of Award:

 - daily allowance: **42,000 yen**
 - Family allowance: **10, 000 yen** per day etc.

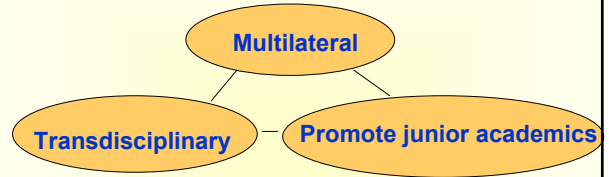

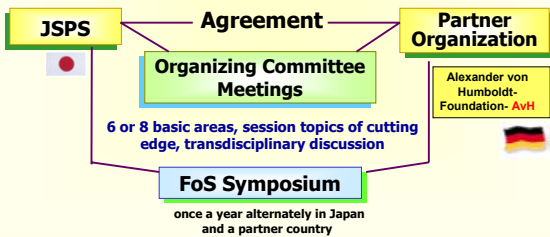


5-1 FoS Frontier of Science Symposium Series

- Foster future research leaders

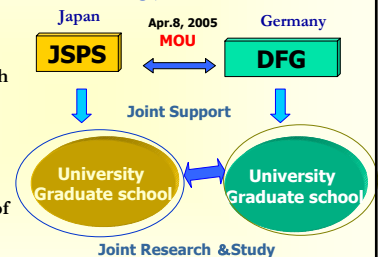

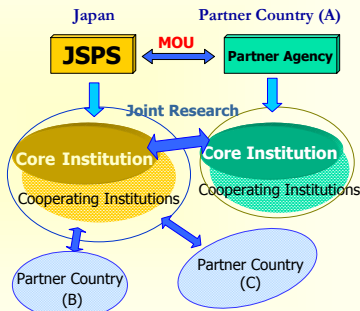
